**Social Media:** Parents of children in North Yorkshire schools are increasingly using social networking sites such as Facebook, Instagram and Twitter to talk to their friends. Sometimes these sites have been used to criticise or make inappropriate comments about pupils, schools or individual members of staff.

Many of these sites are intended for those over the age of 13 and some for over 18s. Internet safety and guidance is taught in school as part of PSHE. However, we still encourage all parents to check on their child's use of the internet, both to ensure their safety and also that they are using appropriate sites in a respectful manner.

Making defamatory comments on the internet has exactly the same serious legal consequences as if they are made directly to someone else. Legal action could be taken against the person (or their guardian) who has made the outline comment. Similarly threats of violence can lead to criminal proceedings under the Malicious Communication Act 1988.

If you have any concerns about anything which happens in school please speak to your child's class teacher or Mrs Tweddle who will do their best to resolve the matter.
