Sustainable Fabrics and Recycled Materials

This weeks' project is about sustainable fabrics and recycled materials. Although there are tasks, when and how you set out these tasks is up to you. You could create a working document or scrapbook, type up your work, create a PowerPoint presentation or have each task as a separate piece of writing.

- What are sustainable fabrics and recycled materials? Research these and make notes using bullet points as you read. You can also create a word bank and make copies of or save pictures and photographs.
- Think about using related hyphenated words in your work. These can be specific nouns or used for description. For example: Generally, you hyphenate two or more words when they come before a noun they modify and act as a single idea. This is called a compound adjective. Ice and cream becomes ice-cream. State and art becomes state-of-the-art. Add the words you find to your word bank.
- Create a fact file about sustainable fabrics and recycled materials and compare the similarities and differences of the two. Use pictures/sketches if you need to.
- Design your own sustainable and/or recycled outfit. There must be labels and paragraphs to explain your answers. Don't forget to use adjectives and adverbs for descriptive language.
