

As historians we will-

- Understand how toys and books have changed over time.
- Understand historical concepts such as continuity and change and chronology.
- Understand the respects in which toys and books we use currently are similar to and different from those used by our parents, grandparents and great-grandparents.
- Ask and answer historical questions.
- Research our family tree.

As athletes we will-

- Go swimming once a week to work on becoming competent, confident and proficient swimmers.
- We will be working with a sports coach on a wide range of skills, including gymnastics and ball skills.

As ICT technicians we will-

- Understand what algorithms are; how they are implemented as programs on digital devices; and that programs execute by following precise and unambiguous instructions
- Create and debug simple programs.
- Use logical reasoning to predict the behaviour of simple programs.
- Recognise common uses of information technology beyond school
- Use technology safely and respectfully, keeping personal information private.

As scientists we will-

- Distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made
- Identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock
- Describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials
- Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.

Pupils should use the local environment throughout the year to explore and answer questions about plants growing in their habitat. Where possible, they should observe the growth of flowers and vegetables that they have planted.
