### Maths- Counting in 10s

Counting practice

- o Count to 100 in unison together.
- o Match the count with fingers, standing up one digit for every number spoken.
- o Every time you reach a multiple of 10, i.e. 10, 20, 30, 40, etc. clap your hands and say, "Cuppa tea!"
- o Continue like this all the way to 100 – cuppa tea!
  - o We call the multiples of ten the 'cuppa-tea' numbers because, from 10 onwards, they end ---ty. (twenty, thirty... etc.)
- Count in tens with others on YouTube

## Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2020

### Maths- Counting practice

- o You need a mug and a number of 10p coins.
- o Rehearse counting in tens to 100. Ten, twenty, thirty, etc.
- o With each number you say, throw out ten fingers!
- o Now ask your child to shut their eyes or turn their back.
- o Drop 10p coins into the mug, one at a time, so that the child can hear the 'clink' as each coin lands.
- o Pause when you have dropped in four 10p coins.

- o Ask how much is in the mug. The child should have been counting the clinks. Ten, twenty, thirty, forty. They tell you.
- o Repeat several times, dropping different numbers of coins each time
