

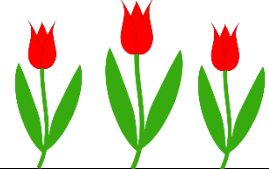


SPRING ACTIVITIES

<h3>Easter egg heads</h3> <p>After boiling eggs, clean out the shells, add funny eyes with a pen or stick on eyes, place damp cotton wool in the bottom, add cress or chive seeds and watch their hair grow!</p> 	<h3>Springtime</h3> <p>Take a photo, record a video, or make a poster to describe the best thing about spring</p> 	<h3>Home grown tomatoes</h3> <p>Did you know that you can grow your own tomato plants from fresh tomato seeds?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remove the seeds from a ripe tomato and soak in tepid water for 14 hours • Dry using paper towel • Plant in a container filled with compost within 7 days • Watch them grow 😊
<h3>Create a fact file</h3> <p>Choose from the following topics to create your fact file;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Why do we have seasons? • Animals born in spring • Butterflies • Spring flowers 	<h3>Easter tree</h3> <p>Collect branches from your garden, or park, and decorate with homemade Easter decorations</p> 	<h3>Learn a new craft</h3> <p>Have you ever thought 'I wish I could do that'? Take some time to learn a new craft. It could be sewing, origami, soap making or pottery. There are so many different crafts to choose from!</p>
<h3>Edible spring scene</h3> <p>Get creative and make a springtime scene that you can eat for dinner!</p> 	<h3>Weather watcher</h3> <p>For one week, keep a diary of the weather. You could include the temperature, wind speed/direction, hours of sunshine and rainfall.</p> <p>How is Spring weather different to other seasons?</p> <p>Why not try to make your own weather station?</p> 	<h3>Easter Bonnet or Mask</h3> <p>Have a go at making your own Easter themed bonnet or mask.
