As designers and artists, we will-

- Research William Morris and his work.
- -Explore the arts and crafts movement.
- -Investigate sketching and still life drawing.
- -Look at pavilion structures and explore their features.

As historians we will-

- -Study the Victorian era in Britain.
- -Explore the life of a rich and a poor child in Victorian times.
- Look at how industry developed and how this shaped Britain
- -Discover famous Victorian's and inventors.
- Explore the British Empire and what it looked like in Victorian times.
- Look at how the development of mining in Rosedale influenced the local area at that time.

- -recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light
