- Investigate how food chains work and create our own.

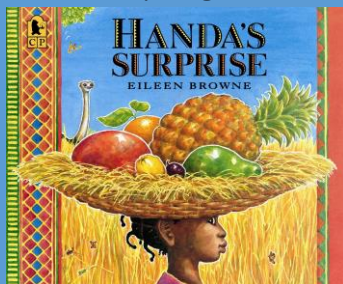
As athletes we will-
